For many years the American Chamber of Commerce in Thailand (AMCHAM) has supported bright and needy university students during final three years of study. This year, the American Chamber of Commerce in Thailand Foundation (ATF), will once again offer scholarships to students of selected public universities throughout the country.

We are pleased to include your university as one of the selected institutions in the ATF Scholarship program. In order to allow your students time to prepare their applications, could you please circulate this information to the following faculties and departments: Engineering, Sciences, Technology, Humanities & Social Sciences, Management Science, Health Science, Economics, Commerce & Accountancy, Education, Agricultural Science.

Each university is invited to nominate students with 3 years remaining for study (i.e. year 2 of 4-year course, year 3 of 5 year course) who meet our criteria provided with this letter. Please nominate candidates having them apply online at <https://www.amchamthailand.com/amcham-scholarships> and sending copies of their academic records and other required documents to reach us by no later than August 31, 2021.

As part of our student scholarship project, AMCHAM organizes two annual programs. The first is an orientation camp for new intake students which gives them insight into the program and our community service requirements. The other is a career camp for students in their final year and includes seminars, workshops, networking events and business visits in Bangkok. During this program, the graduating AMCHAM Scholarship Students meet with the AMCHAM Board of Governors and other members, visit members' companies, and have an opportunity to participate in job interviews to prepare students to enter the business world. All new intake and graduating students are expected to participate in one of these camps and the scholarship funds provided include travel costs for attending. The Career Camp is currently planned for the end of October and Orientation Camp will follow in January 2022. Further information will be forwarded on these programs at a later date.
